Why a Product Medley?

- It's the first mini suite that Stampin' Up! has offered!
- Demonstrators have asked for a suite of coordinating products.
- A product grouping is a trend in the crafting industry now.

Benefits:

- It's a Disinktive Photopolymer Stamp Set, so it'll have a variation in color.
- It incorporates 2 ink colors, so you only need 2 ink pads to create numerous projects!
- Complete coordination! Just add ink!

General Tips:

- **Rose Gold Shimmer Paint**—Be sure to shake the bottle well before using!
- **Rose Gold Adhesive Backed Mirror Embellishments**—You have to “bend” the sheet in order to pop the round embellishment out of the frame. It also has a “protective” covering on top to it, so use the Take Your Pick Tool (#144107) to gently pull the covering off the round surface.
- **6” x 6” One Sheet Wonder**—Cutting designer paper, so there is little to no waste!

Foil Sheet Tips:

- Foil Sheets tend to get “scratch” marks on it when rolling through the Big Shot. (The scratches transfer from the cutting pads.) Be sure to use a foil sheet the same size as the die!

Techniques:

- **1st, 2nd, and 3rd Generation Stamping**—Ink the image once and stamp 3 times on cardstock.
- **Rose Gold Foil Sheets**—Ink the image in VersaMark ink (#102283), use clear emboss powder (#109130), and heat with heat tool (#129053). Use Block D and apply all 4 leaf images to the block. Stamp, heat emboss, and use the dies to cut out several shapes at one time!
- **Rose Gold Shimmer Paint**—Using an Aqua Painter (#103954), add 4 drops of shimmer paint and fill the remainder with 70% rubbing alcohol. Tighten the cap, shake well, and use it to paint a background on Shimmery White Cardstock or Watercolor Paper.
- **Rose Gold Shimmer Paint**—Using a Stampin' Spritzer (#126185), add 3 drops of shimmer paint and fill the remainder with 70% rubbing alcohol. Tighten the cap, shake well, and use it to “spritz” the background of a project.
- **Printed Die Cuts**—Yes, you can color these before embellishing a project! Two options... Stampin' Write Markers and Stampin' Blends. If using Stampin' Blends, be careful to not color the foil on the die cuts. You won't be able to wipe it off.

Gift Card Measurements:

- **Night of Navy Cardstock (yields 2 gift card holders):** 7 1/2” x 11”; Score along the 7 1/2” side @ 2” and 5 1/2”; Cut along the 11” side @ 5 1/2”
- **Melon Mambo Cardstock:** 5 3/8” x 1 7/8”
- **DSP:** 5 1/4” x 1 3/4”
- **Night of Navy Cardstock (Belly Band):** 1 1/2” x 8 1/2”; Score along the 8 1/2” @ 1 1/2” and 5”; Close with Tear & Tape
